Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for the admission to **Diploma in Animal Husbandry** in the following constituent (10) and affiliated (12) Animal Husbandry Polytechnics (AHPs) of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University (SVVU) for the academic year 2026-27.

1. COURSE PARTICULARS:

A. Duration of Course:

Duration of Diploma in Animal Husbandry is 2 years. Each year consists of 2 semesters i.e., 4 Semesters in 2 years. Study Programme includes Course Work during first 3 semesters and Work Experience Programme during 4th semester.

B. Medium of Instructions:

The Diploma in Animal Husbandry will be dealt in **English medium**.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

The students who have completed **10th class or equivalent examination** are only eligible to apply for the Diploma in Animal Husbandry.

3. AGE :

The candidates applying for Diploma in Animal Husbandry course should be between **15** and **22** years old as on **31-08-2026** (Born between **01-09-2004** to **31-08-2011**).

4. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:

(a) The students are selected for the Diploma in Animal Husbandry based on the aggregate of marks (or) overall grade point of the students obtained in 10th standard or any other equivalent examination.

(b) In any case 2 or more students attain same aggregate of marks (or) overall grade point average, marks in Science subject will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit list.

(c) In any case 2 or more students attain same aggregate of marks (or) overall grade point average and same equal marks in Science subject, then the marks in Mathematics shall be taken into consideration while preparing the merit list.

(d) In any case 2 or more students attain same aggregate of marks (or) overall grade point average same marks in Science & Mathematics, then the marks in Social studies shall be taken into consideration while preparing the merit list.

(e) If any case 2 or more students attain same aggregate of marks (or) overall grade point average and same marks in Science, Mathematics and Social studies, then the candidate with higher date of birth (Higher age) will be considered while making the merit list.

Note: ICSE students need to enter average of three subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) for science and two subjects (History & Civics and Geography) for social.

5. LOCAL AREA AND REGION WISE RESERVATION:

Among the total seats, 15% are Un-Reserved seats for the candidates of two local areas (AU and SVU) of Andhra Pradesh and will be filled on merit basis. For remaining 85%, the seats will be allotted on 65.62 and 34.38 ratio among Andhra University (AU) region (Former Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam) and Sri Venkateswara University (SVU) region (Former Districts of Chittoor, Ananthapur, Kurnool, Kadapa and Nellore) respectively (G.O.Ms.No.20 of Higher Education Department, Govt. of A.P. Dt: 12-05-2025).

Local Area Means "A candidate shall be regarded as a local candidate if he/she has studied for not less than 4 consecutive academic years in the concerned local area {Andhra University area (erstwhile districts: Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam) or Sri Venkateswara University area (erstwhile districts: Anantapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, YSR Kadapa, Nellore) ending with the qualifying examination, or in event of break of study / studied in distance or open mode, has resided in that local area for a period of 4 years immediately preceding the qualifying examination. Candidates who have studied in the State for 7 consecutive academic years shall be allotted to the local area where they studied the maximum period (or last studied, in case of equal periods).

The remaining 15% un-reserved (UR) seats are open to candidates eligible as locals in both areas, those with 10 years residence in the State (excluding periods of study/employment outside), and children/spouses of employees of State/Central Government, PSUs, Universities, Local Bodies and other notified institutions.

6. RESERVATION:

a) Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from rural area:

Seventy five percent (75%) of the seats in diploma course are reserved for the candidates who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in the schools located in Non-Municipal areas and twenty five percent (25%) of seats are reserved for the candidates who have studied in Municipal area. The students who have studied a minimum of 4 years from Non Municipal area (Rural) out of their 10 years of study (1st Class to 10th Class) are eligible for admission under rural area. For which the student is advised to fill up the **Form-I** duly signed by the Head Master of the concerned school where he/ she has studied. In case, if the student has studied in one or more schools he/she has to enclose separate Form-I from each school.

- **FORM-I:** It is a proforma to be certified by the **Headmaster** of the school with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in the school located in Non-Municipal area during their period of study from 1st class to 10th class (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**).
- If **FORM-I** is not filed in or duly signed by the concerned Head of the Institution or Officer along with office seal, the claim of the candidates will be rejected and will be considered under **Municipal area (Urban)**.

b) Rule of reservation will be followed as per the rules prescribed by Govt of AP time to time:

- i) 29%** seats are allocated to Backward class (**BC**) candidates.
BC-A: 7%, BC-B: 10%, BC-C: 1%, BC-D: 7% and BC-E: 4%.
- ii) 15%** seats are allocated to Scheduled cast (**SC**) candidates.
Group I: 1%, Group II: 6.5%, Group III: 7.5%.
- iii) 6%** seats are allocated to Scheduled Tribe (**ST**) candidates.
- iv) 33.1/3 %** seats are allocated to **Girls /Women**.

c) Reservations for Special Categories:

- i) 5%** seats are allocated to **Physically Challenged/ Differently Able Candidates**.
- ii) 2%** seats are allocated to Children of Armed Personnel (CAP).
- iii) 1%** seats are allocated to National Cadet Corps (NCC).
- iv) 0.5%** seats are allocated to Sports quota.
- v) 0.5%** seats are allocated to Scots and Guides quota.

d) Economically Weaker Section (over and above)

- i) 10%** supernumerary seats shall be made available to **EWS** category.

7. NATIVITY / RESIDENCE CERTIFICATE:

Applicants who have gap / break during the study period for reasons other than failure or those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit **Nativity Certificate** issued by the Tahsildar. In case, the applicant has resided in more than one place, a separate certificate from the respective Tahsildars should be furnished for such places of residence.

8. REGISTRATION AND COUNSELLING FEE:

General Category and Backward Caste Category students have to pay **Rs.1,100/-** while the SC/ST & P.H. Candidates have to pay **Rs.550/-** for online registration and counseling.

The applicant has to select Rupay Debit Card/ UPI/ Debit Card /Credit Card (Visa /Master Card)/Internet Banking option to pay the fee and follow the online instructions to complete payment of fee

Once payment made, it cannot be refunded under any circumstances, hence applicant should go through the information bulletin carefully regarding eligibility criteria before proceeding to the payment.

9. ONLINE COUNSELING:

Candidates should fill the online application carefully and check details such as local area / municipal / non municipal area, reservation / special categories etc. and submit the application online.

- **It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he/she fulfills the specified eligibility before applying/filling application form.**
- **No corrections will be permitted once the application form is submitted online.**
- Please note that University/AH Polytechnic will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible candidates.
- Multiple application forms submitted by a candidate will not be accepted and will lead to the cancellation of his/her seat.
- Government decided to link the scholarship applications with the Aadhar number for affecting the cash transaction scheme. For this every student must furnish the Aadhar number vide Government memo No. 16035/Sw. Edn.2/2012-4 dt. 29.12.2012.
 - The admissions to Diploma in Animal Husbandry in AH Polytechnics under SVVU and affiliated to SVVU for the academic year 2026-27 shall be made on the basis of Web Counseling. Where in candidates can opt for any AH Polytechnic in order of priority and the allotment shall be made for his/her best preferred choice based on his/her merit and other admission rules in vogue.
- Candidates have to opt preferable Animal Husbandry Polytechnic (Web options) after thorough enquiry and examination about the AH Polytechnics in different districts of Andhra Pradesh.
- The order of options is to be entered by the candidate carefully. A print out of the options entered shall be kept as record for reference. Candidate can opt minimum one polytechnic and maximum 22 polytechnics.
- Candidates should download the allotment order and report at the allotted Polytechnic within the prescribed time.
- **The selection of candidates belonging to CAP/ PH/ NCC/ Sports/ Scouts and Guides is subject to clearance to be given by the respective departments during the counseling.**
- **Registrar, SVVU is not responsible for the delay in clearance in respect of doubtful Caste/CAP/PH/ NCC/ Sports/ Scouts and Guides cases.**
- Any disputes concerned to admissions shall be within the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble A.P. High court.

i. If the admitted candidate cancels his / her seat before the closure of admissions (mop-up round) for the Academic Year 2026-27 an amount of Rs.1,720/- under general quota and BC and Rs.860/- under SC/ST/PH quota shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.

ii. If the admitted candidate cancels his / her seat after closure of admission process (mop-up round) for the Academic Year 2026-27 the candidate has to forfeit the fees already paid and in addition, he/she has to pay processing of Rs.1,720/- under general quota and BC and Rs.860/- under SC/ST/PH quota.

iii. After completion/closing of admission process, request for change of Animal Husbandry polytechnic is not permissible under any circumstances.

12. HOSTEL FACILITY:

Hostel facility is available separately for both boys and Girls in all AH Polytechnics of SVVU. If a student wants to stay outside, he has to obtain prior permission from the concerned Principal of the AH Polytechnic.

13. ELIGIBILITY FOR OTHER DEGREE PROGRAMMES:

As per G.O.Rt.No.17, Dt.10-02-2021, Government of A.P., permission has been accorded to the Universities, Colleges and Institutes etc., to admit 2 year Diploma holders awarded by SVVU into B.Sc. Biology stream programmes / combinations and other relevant disciplines as well as B.Com and B.A. without Mathematics and Statistics subjects.

14. IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Candidates are required to read the INFORMATION BULLETIN thoroughly before applying.
- Universities are intended to impart education to students, undertake research and extension activities. Hence, **University does not guarantee any employment to the students who complete Diploma in Animal Husbandry.**
- **The candidates completing the Diploma in Animal Husbandry course are not eligible for B.V.Sc., & A.H course admissions.**
- All the applications shall be uploaded online with relevant documents within the due date.
- **The University has right to change or cancel the admission process.**
- The University/AP Online shall send SMS to the applicant's registered mobile for the purposes related to counseling. Hence, the Candidates are informed to mention their personal mobile numbers but not the mobile numbers of relatives, friends, net / online / Xerox centers etc. Once submitted, the mobile number cannot be changed.
- Applicants should exercise web option through online at specified dates for choosing their preference of AH Polytechnic. SMS alert shall be sent to registered mobile number for this purpose.
- Candidates are informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for counseling does not guarantee seat allotment.

- Candidate should submit all the Certificates in Original and pay the prescribed fees at the time of admission in the allotted AH Polytechnic within in the due date.
- The certificates of the candidates under special categories (**PH, CAP, NCC, SPORTS and SCOUTS & GUIDES**) shall be verified by the authorities concerned. The university will not interfere in the process of preparation of priority / merit lists. The University allots seats to the candidates based on the priorities indicated by the competent authorities.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the university will take appropriate action against the individuals concerned and his/her application will be summarily rejected.
